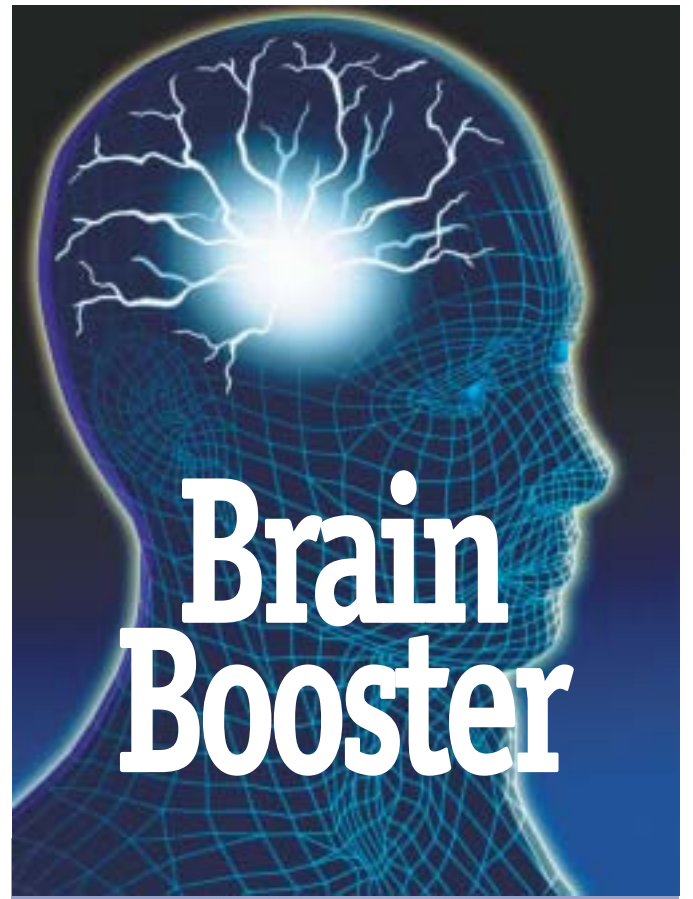

- What's a hink pink for something you see that glows?

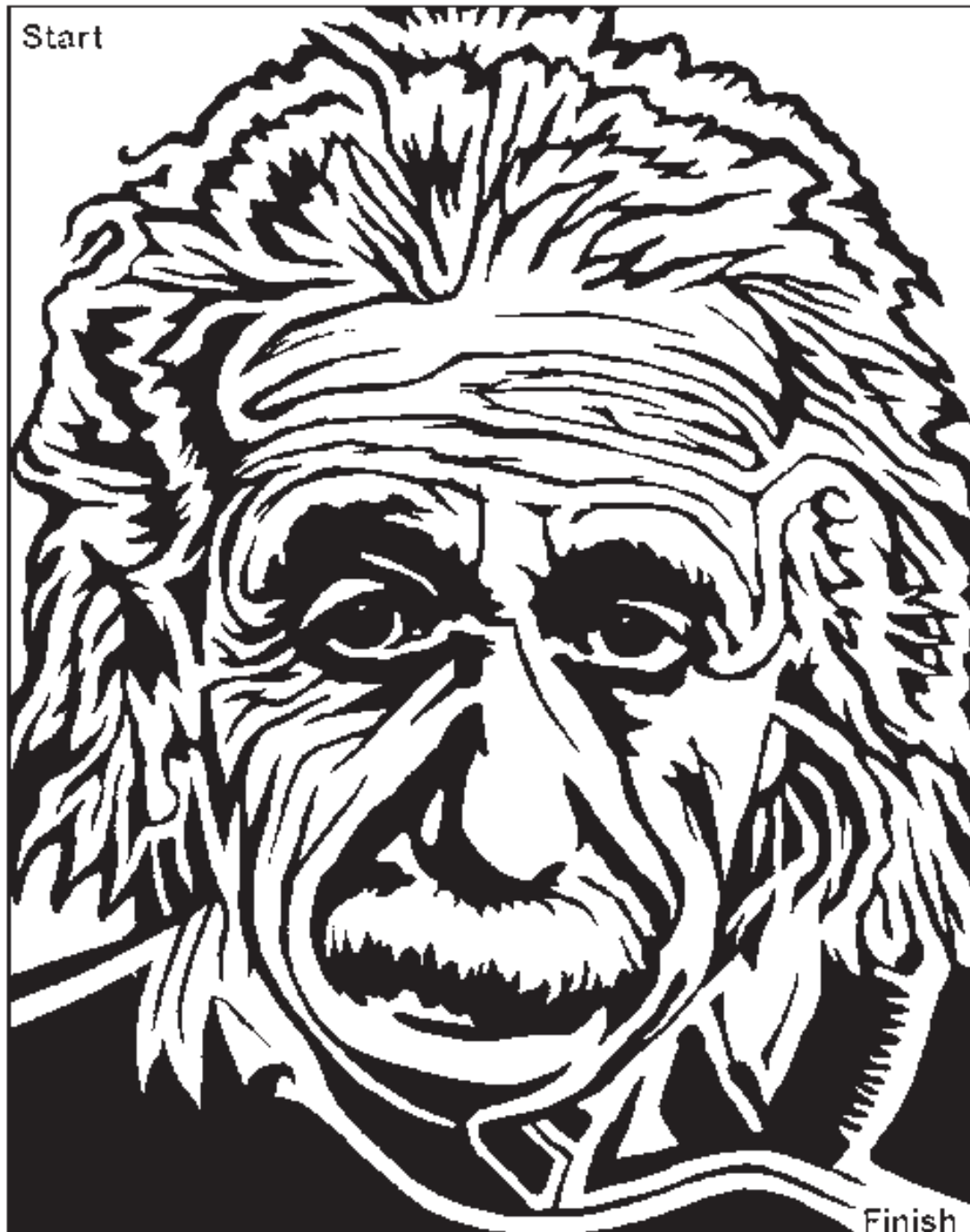
